

**Greensburg City Council
Special Meeting
April 9, 2015

Item 1: Opening Session

Call to Order; Roll Call

Mayor Robert Dixon called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on April 9, 2015. Council present: Matt Christenson, Mark Trummel, Sandy Jungemann, Rick Schaffer, and Haley Kern. Also present: City Administrator Ed Truelove, City Attorney Gordon Stull, and City Clerk Christy Pyatt.

Item 2: Executive Session for Non-Elected Personnel

Truelove requested executive session for non-elected personnel for 30 minutes. Kern made a motion to go into executive session for non-elected personnel until 6:30 p.m. Jungemann seconded, and the motion passed 5-0. Dixon left executive session at 6:10 p.m. and returned, upon request at 6:25 p.m. Dixon declared the meeting in open session at 6:30 p.m. Trummel made a motion, seconded by Jungemann, to go into executive session for non-elected personnel until 6:45 p.m. Motion passed 5-0. Dixon declared the meeting back in open session at 6:45 p.m.

Item 3: Business

A. Consider accepting the resignation of City Administrator Ed Truelove, effective April 28, 2015.

Trummel made a motion to, regretfully, accept a letter of resignation from City Administrator Ed Truelove, effective April 28, 2015. Jungemann seconded. Motion passed 5-0. Truelove clarified that April 28th will be a working day for him.


B. Discuss and consider the appointment of an Interim City Administrator.

Christenson made a motion, seconded by Trummel, to reach out to Austin Peters Group to conduct a City Administrator recruitment process. Motion passed 5-0.

Trummel recommended Council contact former Interim City Administrator Jay Newton to determine his availability. Stull offered a copy of the previous interim employment agreement. Christenson voiced that the agreement should be similar to the previous offered to Newton. Trummel stated that if Newton agrees to assist the City a special council meeting should be called before the next regular council meeting. Trummel made a motion, seconded by Christenson, to direct the Mayor to contact Jay Newton regarding the position of Interim City Administrator. Motion passed 5-0.
