

ORDINANCE NO. 1026
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CITY CODE OF
THE CITY OF GREENSBURG BY RESCINDING SECTION 4-218 AND
AMENDING SECTION 4-219 IN THE
CITY OF GREENSBURG, KANSAS.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
GREENSBURG, KANSAS:**

Section 1. Chapter IV, Sections 4-218 of the Code of the City of Greensburg, requiring builders or building contractors to secure a \$5,000 corporate surety bond, is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. Chapter IV, Section 4-219 of the Code of the City of Greensburg is hereby amended to read as follows:

"4-219 INSURANCE.

A builder or building contractor must procure and maintain a liability insurance policy in the amount of \$1,000,000 for each occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate for bodily injury, and \$100,000 each occurrence for property damage. Such policies of insurance shall be issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in the State of Kansas. A builder or building contractor may qualify as to the insurance requirements by filing a certificate with the city clerk, executed by the resident agent of such company stating, stating that the required policy of insurance has been issued by such company for the purpose required by this article and that such insurer will not cancel the policy except upon giving 30 days notice in writing to the city; and that the certificate shall be filed for an annual period beginning January 1 and ending December 31 of such year."

Section 3. Chapter IV Section 4-216 of the Code of the City of Greensburg is hereby amended to read as follows:

"4-216 SAME; APPLICATION; GRANTING.

Application for a builder's or building contractor's license shall be made upon a form to be supplied by the city. New Licenses shall provide proof of licensure in another jurisdiction or letters of reference for the applicant are required. The license or letters of reference must verify proficiency in the same trade that the builder or building contractor has referenced in his application for registration in the City of Greensburg.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 2013.
