

ORDINANCE NO. 1029

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1025 OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, KIOWA COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Greensburg, Kansas, recently adopted Ordinance No. 1025 vacating a portion of North Oak Street and Utility Easements between Ohio Avenue and the Northern right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad, platted in the original town plat of the City of Greensburg, Kiowa County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, after adoption and publication of Ordinance No. 1025, a drafting error was realized in the legal description contained in the Ordinance and the City was without power or authority to adopt said Ordinance due to the error and therefore it needs to be repealed to clarify.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Greensburg, Kansas:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No 1025 is hereby repealed;

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Kiowa County Register of Deeds Office for appropriate recording.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
