

ORDINANCE NO. 1037

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1020 OF  
THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, KANSAS**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Greensburg, Kansas:

**SECTION 1.** Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1020 of the City of Greensburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 4. PROHIBITION OF OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, POCKET BIKES, AND MOTORIZED SCOOTERS.

- (a) Except as hereinafter provided, the operation of all-terrain vehicles, pocket bikes and motorized scooters on the streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the City of Greensburg, Kansas, is prohibited.
- (b)
  - (1) All-terrain vehicles owned and operated by employees of the Board of County Commissioners of Kiowa County, Kansas, the City of Greensburg, Kansas, and Unified School District 442 may be operated on the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the city while in use in connection with public maintenance operations, provided the operator has a valid Kansas driver’s license and the owner has registered the all-terrain vehicle and has the insurance required by Sections 7, 8 and 9.
  - (2) No all-terrain vehicles may be operated upon any public highway, street, road and alley with a posted speed limit in excess of 30 miles per hour.
  - (3) No all-terrain vehicle shall be operated on any interstate highway, federal highway or state highway; provided, however, that the provisions of this subsection shall not prohibit an all-terrain from crossing a federal or state highway or a street or highway with a posted speed limit greater than 30 miles per hour.
  - (4) No all-terrain vehicle shall be operated on any public highway, street, road or alley between sunset and sunrise.
  - (5) Every person operating an all-terrain vehicle on the public highways, streets, roads and alleys of the city shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle imposed by law.”

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official City newspaper and passed by the governing body of the City of Greensburg, Kansas, this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2013.
