

ORDINANCE NO. 1056

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 1042 AND AMENDING CHAPTER XIV, SECTION 14-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, KANSAS, 2014 ADOPTING AND INCORPORATING THE 2014 STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Greensburg, Kansas:

SECTION 1: Section 14-101 of the Code of the City of Greensburg, Kansas incorporating by reference the Standard Traffic Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

14-101. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Greensburg, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2014, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1056", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge, city attorney and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section 2: Ordinance 1042 or portions thereof in conflict herewith, including the existing section 14-101, are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on October 1, 2014, after its publication in the official City newspaper.
